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AT THE HEART OF THE KNOW-HOW

MUSEUM OF ENAMELS AND EARTHENWARE

The Museum of Enamels and Earthenware of Longwy presents the most prestigious creations from the city's manufacturers. The faience factories can be visited, allowing you to discover the manufacturing process.



MINETT PARK FOND-DE-GRAS

Historic buildings, a steam train «Train 1900», an old fashioned grocery store, a power plant and a rolling mill train ... no, you're not dreaming, all this is very real and can be discovered at the Minett Park Fond-de-Gras.



STAINED GLASSES MAJORELLE

The former Grand Bureaux of the Longwy Steelworks house an invaluable treasure: the «Stained Glass Majorelle», in Art-Deco style, they illustrate the theme of the steel industry: «the iron man at work».



DE WENDEL HERITAGE

The blacksmiths who arrived in Hayange in 1704 left a heritage that traces the history of iron in the valley: castles, mansions, workers' housing, religious sites, etc.



LUXEMBOURG'S IRON MINES

At the National Mining Museum, you'll learn all about how mining works and discover more than a century of technological development through its large collection, most of which is displayed in underground galleries.



THE COCKERILL MINE

A group of passionate former miners who wanted to pass their memories on to future generations decided to breathe new life into the old site. Following extensive renovations, the Katzenberg mine is once again a site to discover.



THE HUSSIGNY MINE

You will discover the mining installations with the equipment of the time.



THE IRON MINE IN NEUFCHÉF

A high-place steeped in memory, former miners will introduce you to the history and world of ore mining in real iron mining galleries that were operated 200 years ago.



THE IRON MINE IN AUMETZ

The Aumetz iron mine allows you to understand the history of shaft mines, the daily life and the different jobs of miners in original surface facilities.



THE BELVAL BLAST FURNACES

Witnesses of an era that transformed the country and played a major role in its economic emergence and the lives of its inhabitants, the Belval Blast Furnaces have left their mark Luxembourg's history and the landscape.



THE BLAST FURNACE U4

A strong symbol of the industrial heritage of the Fensch Valley, it is the last of the 6 blast furnaces of the ironworks built in 1890. It is transformed into a work of art: «Tous les soleils» created by Claude Levêque.



OLD MILL IN HATRIZE

A lovely place to discover an old mill. Explanatory panels to show the heyday and the decline of the flour mill.

THE CUSSIGNÈRE SWAMP

This is an over 25 hectares swamp on the French-Belgian Border where Fauna and flora have a lot to offer: harriers, spotted skunk, swamp snipe... and a magnificent live hedge composed of plum trees, aspen, hazelnuts, etc..



LE JARDIN DES TRACES

Set up on an industrial wasteland, the garden is intended to guarantee industrial memory. A place to stroll and relax, stroll between the flows of flowers, sculptures and water jets.



NATURE CONSERVATION CENTER ELLERGRONN

The nature reserve is part of a European network that aims to protect numerous species and their habitats. It's the perfect starting point to discover the surroundings, offering educational walking trails through protected areas..

Amazing gardens, with arboretum, huts and dry stones for a complete zen feeling.

OUR HERITAGE

MEROVINGIAN NECROPOLIS

One of the most important archaeological sites to be visited in the Grand Est region thanks to more than 200 tombs, funeral furniture, a Latin cross, a votive well and a Gallo-Roman fanum.



VAUBAN FORTIFIED CITY

The fortified city of Longwy is one of Vauban's masterpieces and perfectly expresses his conception of the ideal city. The Tourist Office invites you to discover the treasures of this site inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List.



CHAPELLE DE MORLANGE

A haven of peace at the foot of the Justemont hills, the chapel stands discreetly hidden from view, as a rare witness to the Romanesque art left in the Lorraine region.



HISTORIC CITY CENTER

A guided tour of the city's historic heart will transport you to the sources of its history, the Ancient Period to the Middle Ages, end to the industrial era in the oldest iron mine in France!



ROMANESQUE CHURCH

The Romanesque church was built between the 11th and 12th centuries on the Mont-Saint-Martin. The hill overlooks a vast valley open to views of France, Luxembourg and Belgium.



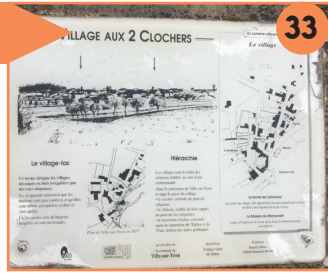
ARCHITECTURAL WALK

At the end of the 19th century, Esch was transformed from a rural town to an industrial town. The flourishing craft industry and the booming industry compete: art deco, neo-gothic, post-modernism.

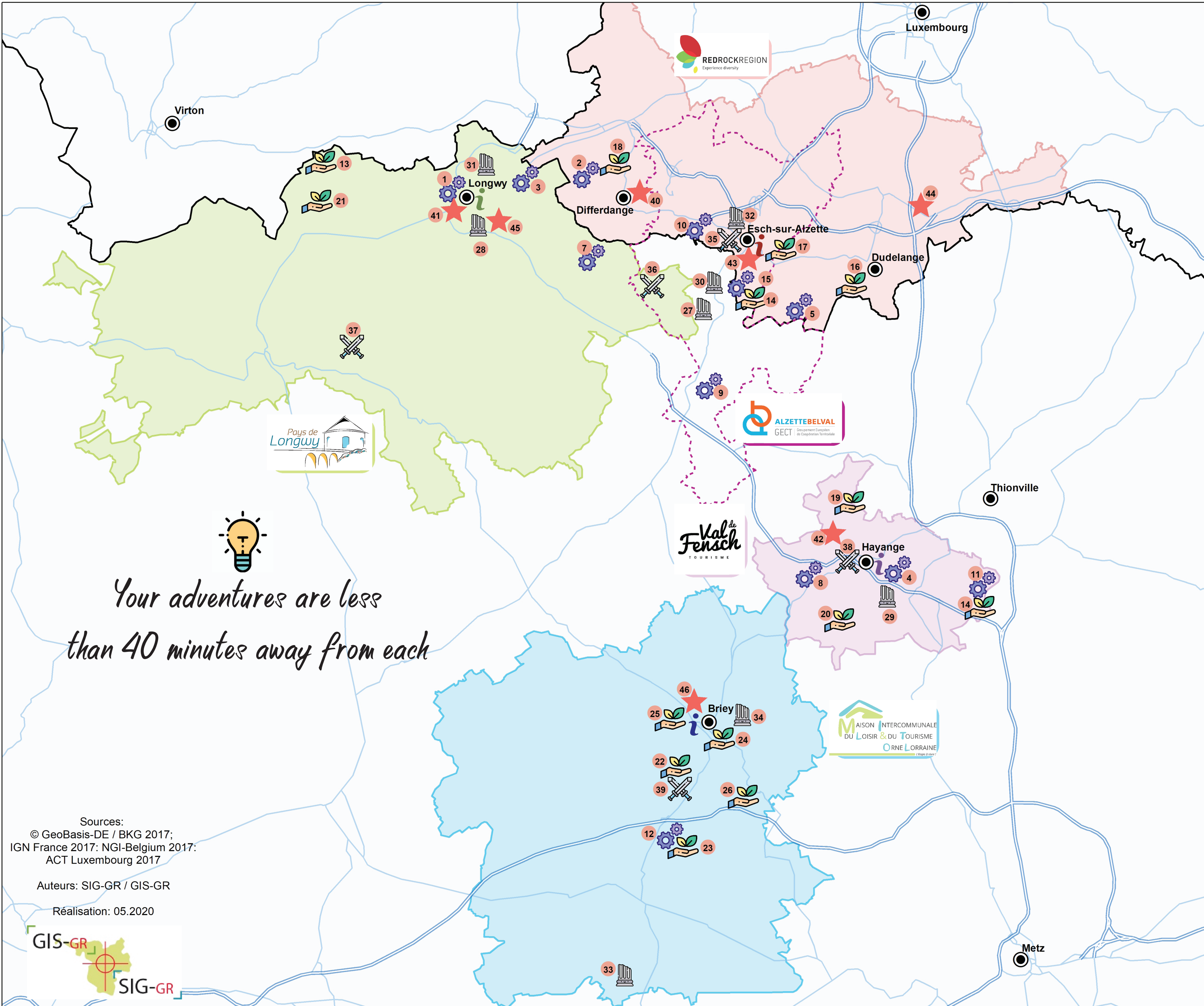
